Al'ed to calve mid-October to the Select Sires calving-ease bull Vermilion Spur B024.

After Al they were turned in with calving-ease, high growth Angus bulls from Uwharrie Ridge Farms (URF Dually G54, URF Blackhawk G14) and EBS Farms (EBS Enhance 023). These heifers have been handled very well, are docile, and have not been pushed hard on feed. The calves out of these heifers should come easy and grow fast.

30 Bred Heifers from Rocking H Cattle Co, Norwood, NC

Angus-based heifers with Simmental or Charolais influence. Sired by generations of EBS Farms Angus bulls and Harward Sisters Angus or Charolais bulls. Bred to a calving-ease Angus bull from EBS Farms (EBS Bonus 140), they are due to start calving mid-October. For over 20 years, the Rocking H herd has focused on breeding for females that calve easy and raise big, stout calves. These heifers have not been pushed hard on feed.

10 Bred Heifers from Green Hills Cattle Co, Mt Ulla, NC

Balancer and Angus-based heifers coming from excellent seedstock genetics. Sired by Balancer, Gelbvieh, and Angus bulls and bred to calving-ease Balancer or Angus bulls. They are due to start calving the end of September through the fall. The Green Hills Cattle Co/Green Hills Gelbvieh herd raises purebred and commercial cattle that are bred to perform for the commercial cattleman in the southeast and excel in hybrid-vigor.

50 Young Bred Cows from JM Cattle Co, Dunn, NC

Young 3-4 year old cows due to start calving this fall. They are Angus-based genetics crossed with a small % Continental. They are bred to Angus bulls. They should raise big, stout calves that will work great as feeder calves or replacement females.
