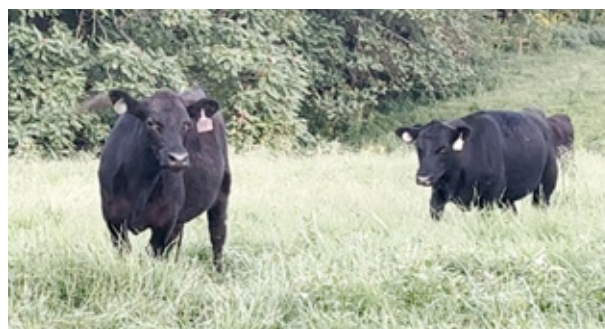

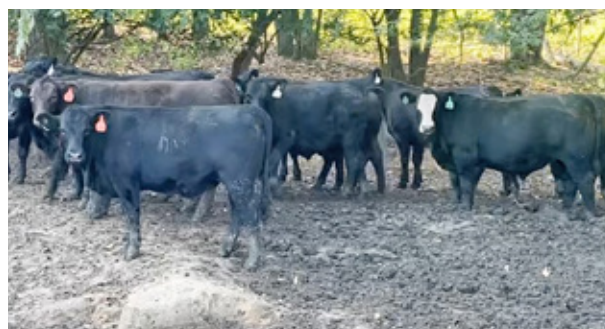

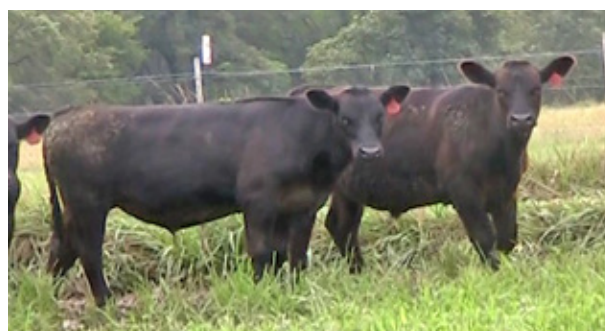

SLIDE OPTIONS

CONVENTIONAL ONE WAY SLIDE

The “price slide” will go into effect when the average net weight of the live cattle is over the base weight the cattle are sold at. This will go into effect starting at 1 pound over the base weight. The price/cwt will be adjusted by the amount stated in the contract for every pound over that weight on the total net pounds.

EXAMPLE: Cattle sold at base weight of 750 lbs. with a \$15/cwt top slide for \$350.00/cwt.

- At delivery the cattle can weigh anything up to 750 lbs. (after shrink) and the price will not change.
- At 1 lb. over the base weight (after shrink) the slide will go into effect.

EXAMPLE: Cattle weigh 765 lbs. after shrink.

765 - 750 lbs. = 15 lbs over

15 lbs x \$15/cwt = \$2.25

\$350.00 - \$2.25 = \$347.75

765 lbs. x \$347.75/cwt = **\$2,660.29**

\$1 TOPSIDE “SLIDE”

There is no conventional slide on the cattle. The seller will be paid the contract price up to the base weight and the amount stated in the contract per pound for every pound over the base weight.

EXAMPLE: Cattle sold at base weight of 750 lbs. for \$350.00/cwt with a \$1 per lb. price at any weight over 750 lbs.

- At delivery all weight up to 750 lbs. (after shrink) will get paid \$350.00/cwt.
- All weight over 750 lbs. (after shrink) will get paid \$1 per lb.

765 - 750 lbs. = 15 lbs over

750 x \$350.00/cwt = \$2,625.00

15 lbs x \$1 = \$15.00

All cattle being offered for sale are under standard Contracts for Sale. All cattle are purchased under standard Contracts for Purchase by the Buyers.
2. The cattle offered for sale are indicated on the sale sheets or online sale description as described to the MACS representatives by the owner. They are described by lot numbers, seller, location of the cattle, numbers of head, estimated weight, management practices, delivery date, conditions of sale and delivery, and verified programs. Representatives for each load are listed under each respective lot. Every effort has been made to assure the correctness of this information but all announcements from the auctioneer or official auction staff prior to or during the sale shall take precedence over printed matter herein.
3. Auction bids will be taken as voice bids by telephone and in person or online bids through DV Auction. Bids are asked with each lot of cattle and will be sold to the highest bidder on the basis of estimated weight. Seller reserves the right to "no sale" the load lot(s) of their cattle at the time the highest bid is made as long as the "no sale" announcement is made prior to the next lot being sold. Any departure from this procedure will be announced and all announcements made from the auctioneer or official auction staff will take precedence over printed matter herein.
